

Cutoff

IIM Bangalore accepts both sectional & overall cutoff for admission process. IIM Bangalore cutoff 2024 will be 85 percentile overall and 80 percentile sectional for the general category students. The below table represents the minimum prescribed cutoffs for preparing shortlist of IIM Bangalore:

Admission

The admission process of IIMB is done via Common Admission Test (CAT). Students need to clear the minimum cutoff percentile in 3 sections (VARC, LRDI, QUANT) and also the total. Then IIMB issues interview call for the shortlisted candidates. Followed by which students are called for personal interview a writing assessment test. After the entire procedure a composite score is generated comprising of several factors including - 10th,12th and graduation marks, gender and academic diversity, work experience, CAT score, and interview marks. Finally offers are rolled out to top candidates. I choose IIMB over other B-Schools because of its legacy in education facilities, vast alumni network, and startup incubations.
